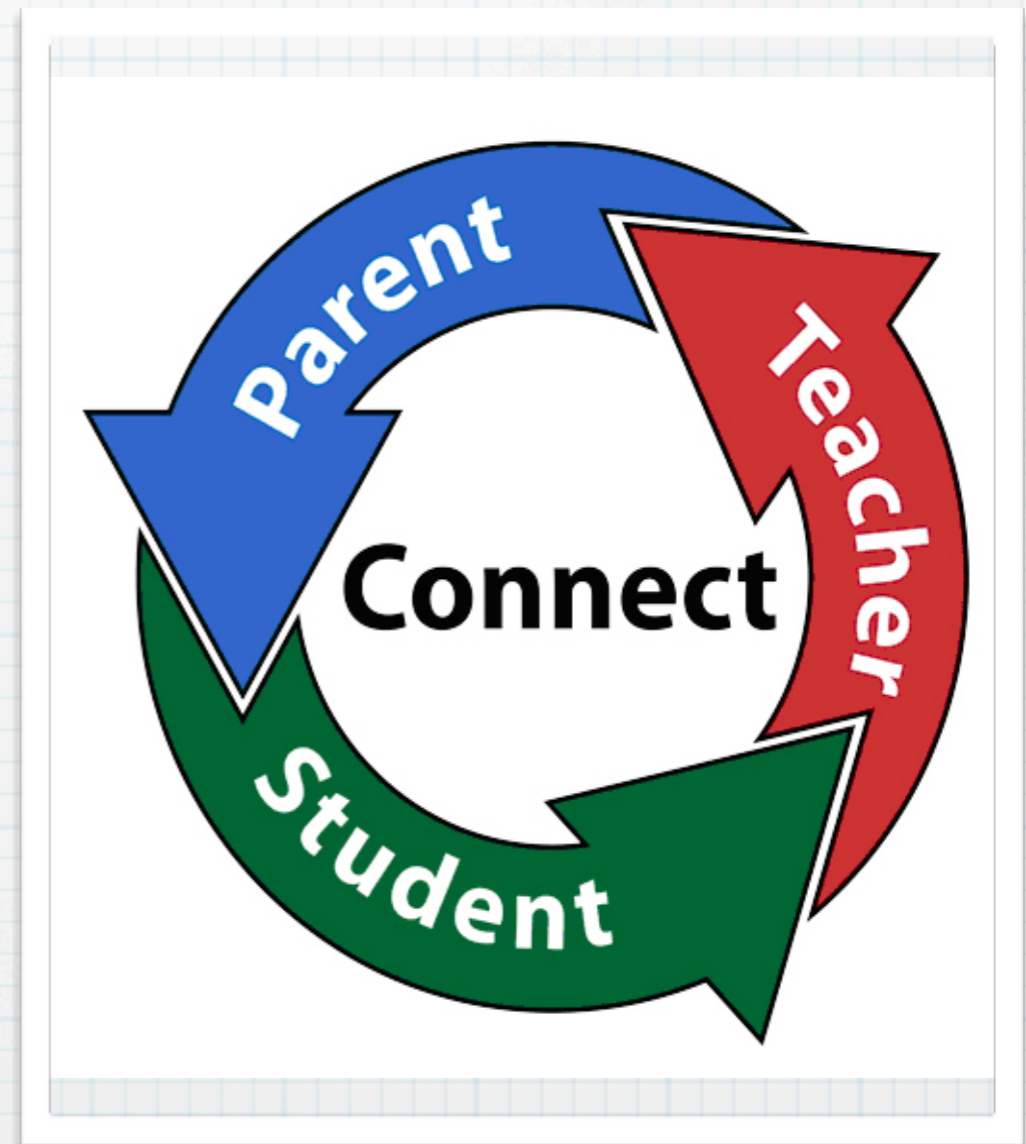

Learning Management = Student Engagement



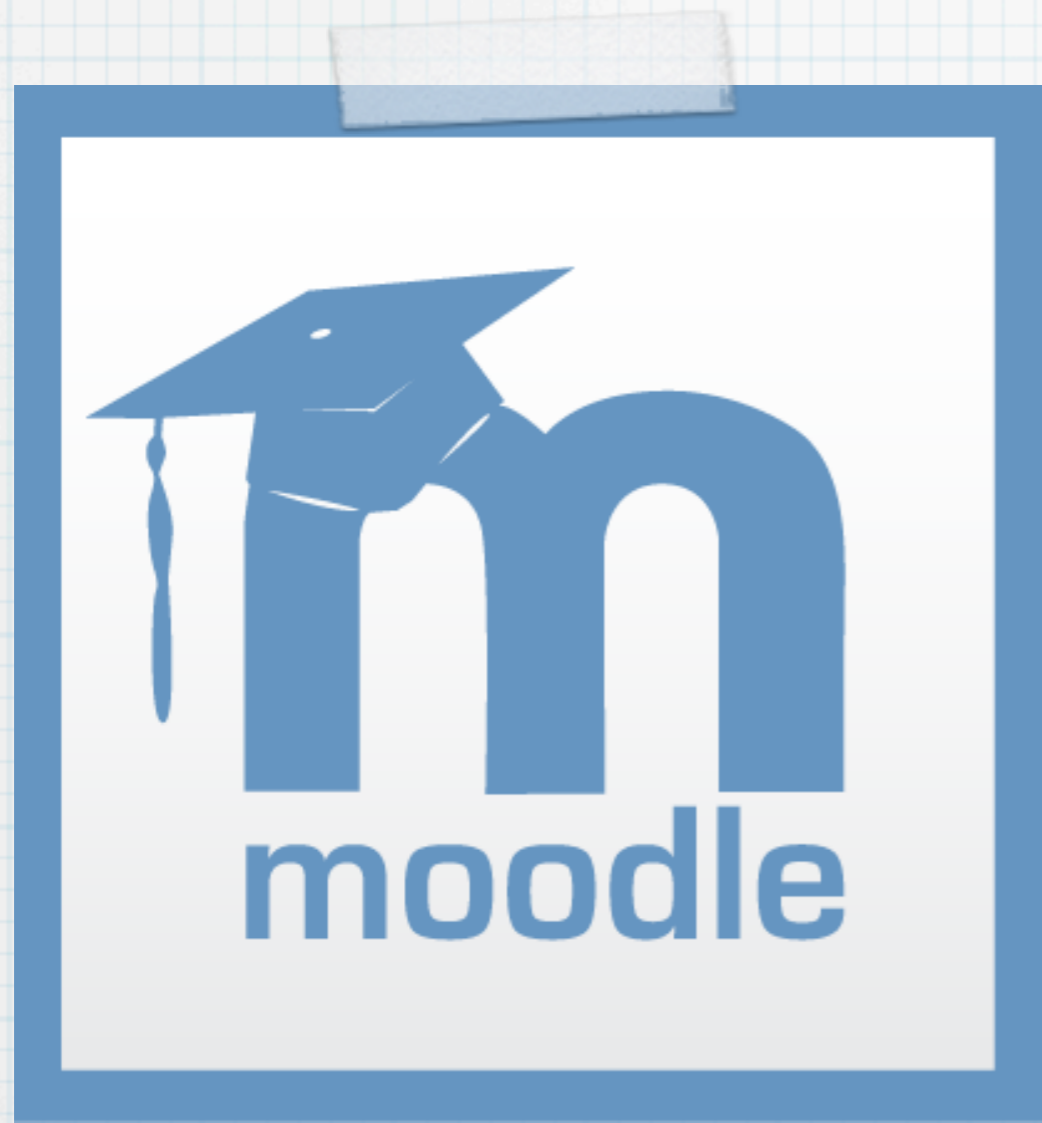
Not A Student Information System!

For students, this encourages them to participate outside of the classroom.

Reason for Moodle

- * More time to think, critical thinking about lessons
- * Supports interactive experiences
- * Allow for autonomy and freedom with moodle. Flexibility is key feature.
- * LMS can (and should) be more than docs and homework

Why Moodle?



*LMS is about engagement with students beyond the traditional classroom experience.

*Moodle potentially provides more regular and instant feedback on work

*Moodle also provides a dynamic calendar of events for the student

*Parents can have more engagement besides waiting for progress reports or report cards

Parent Logins

- * Allow parents to be part of their children's courses
- * Parents login like students
- * Can see student performance, assignments, and grades.
- * Teacher's use as a gradebook

By The Numbers

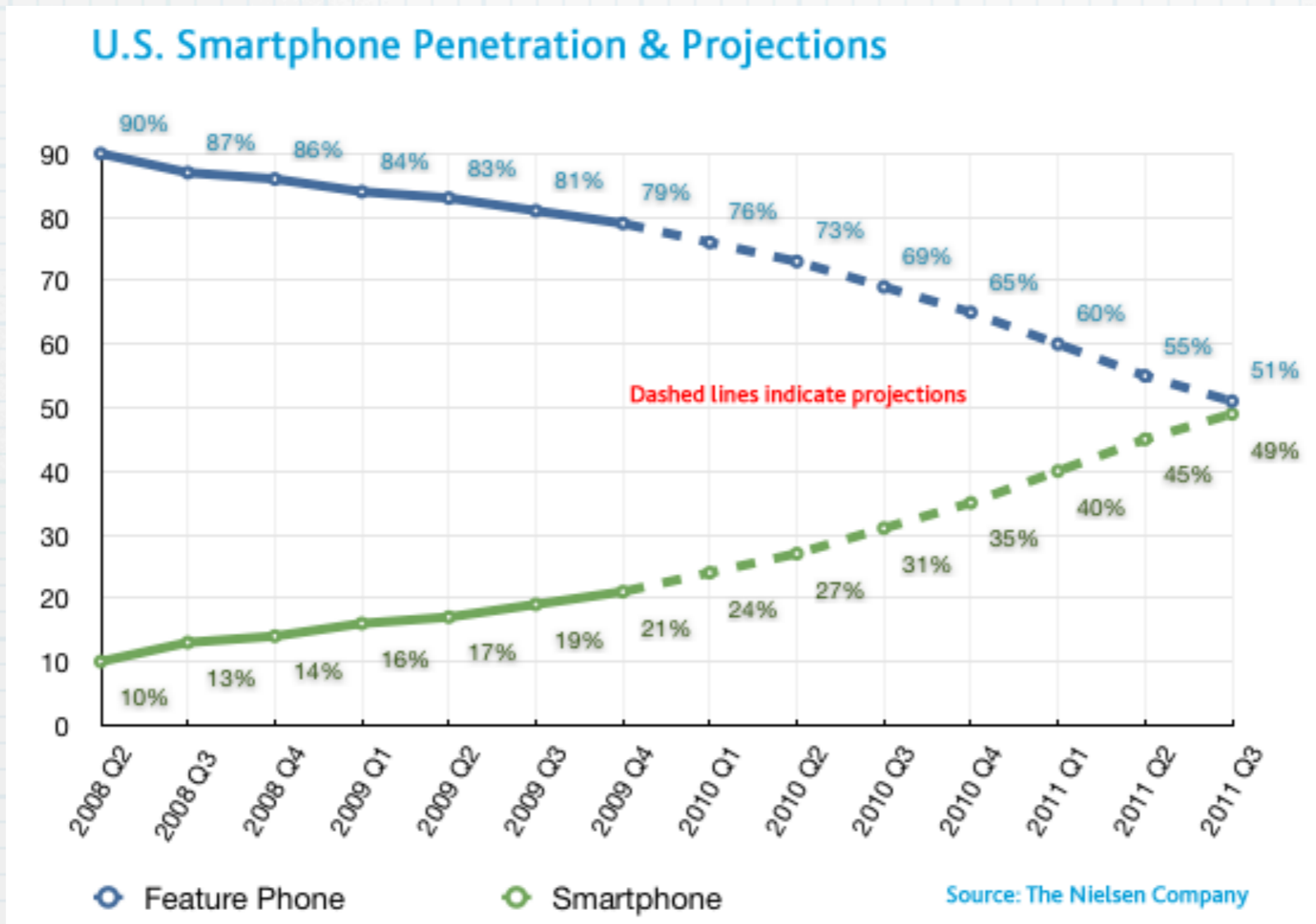
- * 100% teacher regular use adoption rate

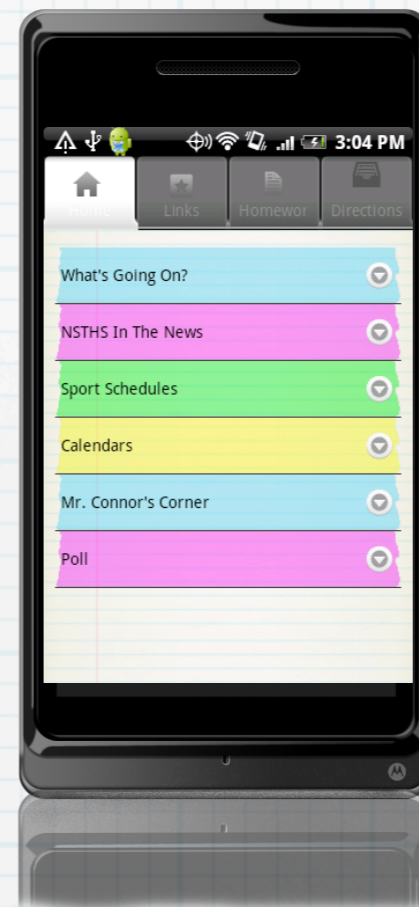
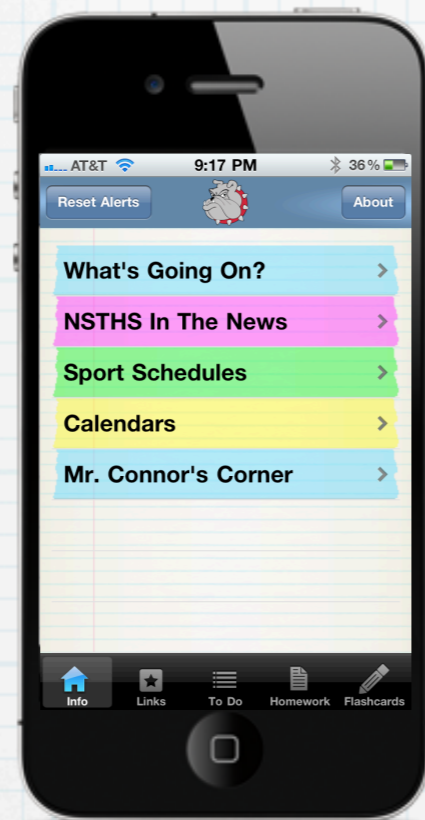
Connecting

Key Stats

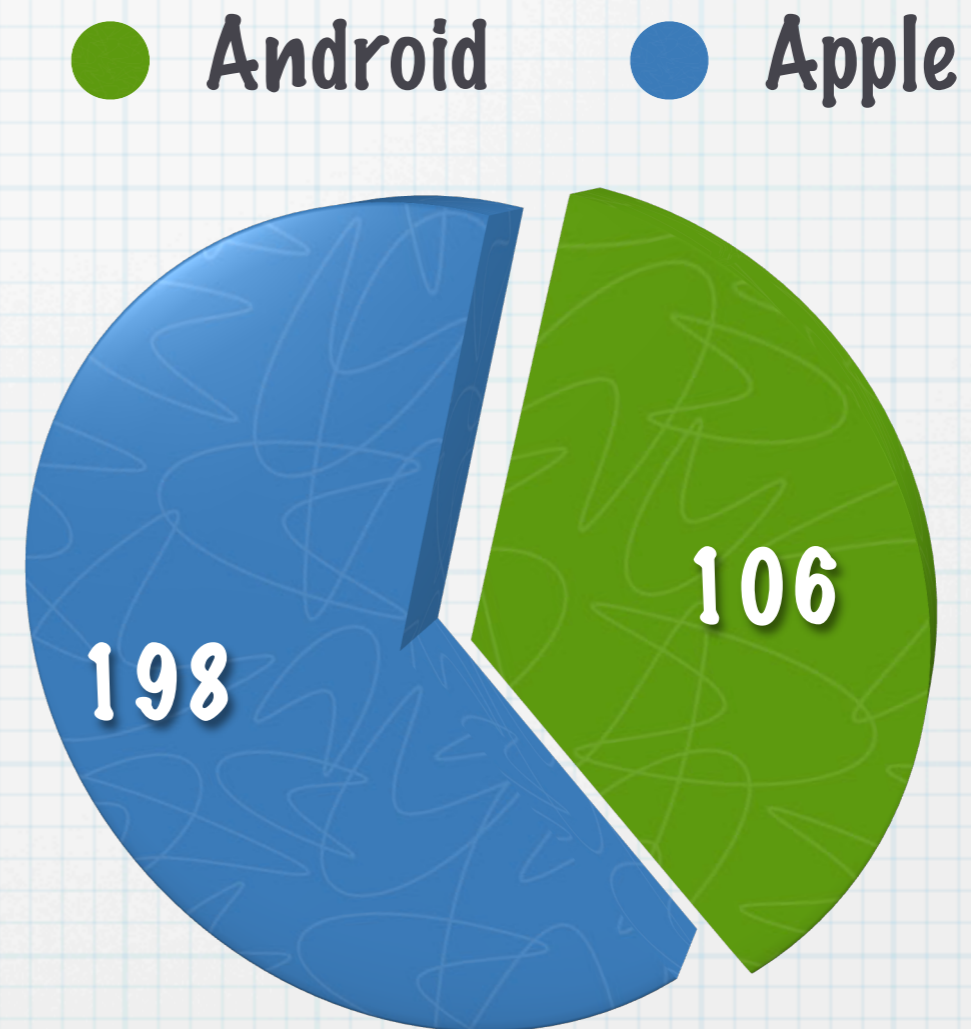
- * About 80% of our students have either smart phones, iPod touches, iPads, or some other type of tablet.
- * Over 70% of that group had Apple products (iPhone, iPod Touch, or iPad).
- * 62% of students prefer mobile devices to communicate and look up info on the internet (Project Tomorrow, 2010).

* Total Currently Installed Downloads as of 10/21 →

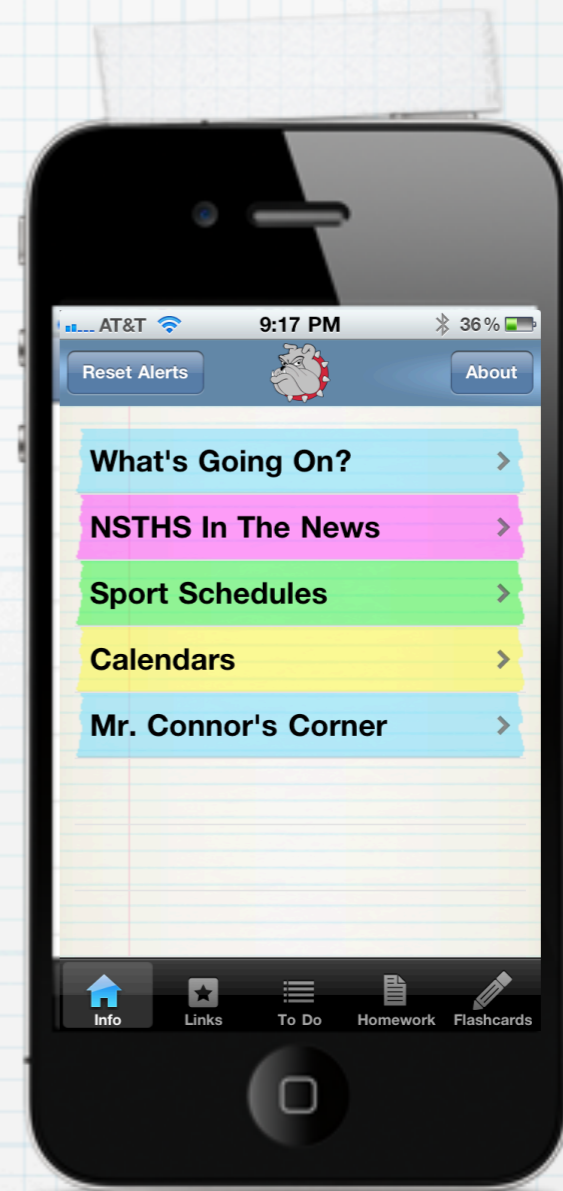

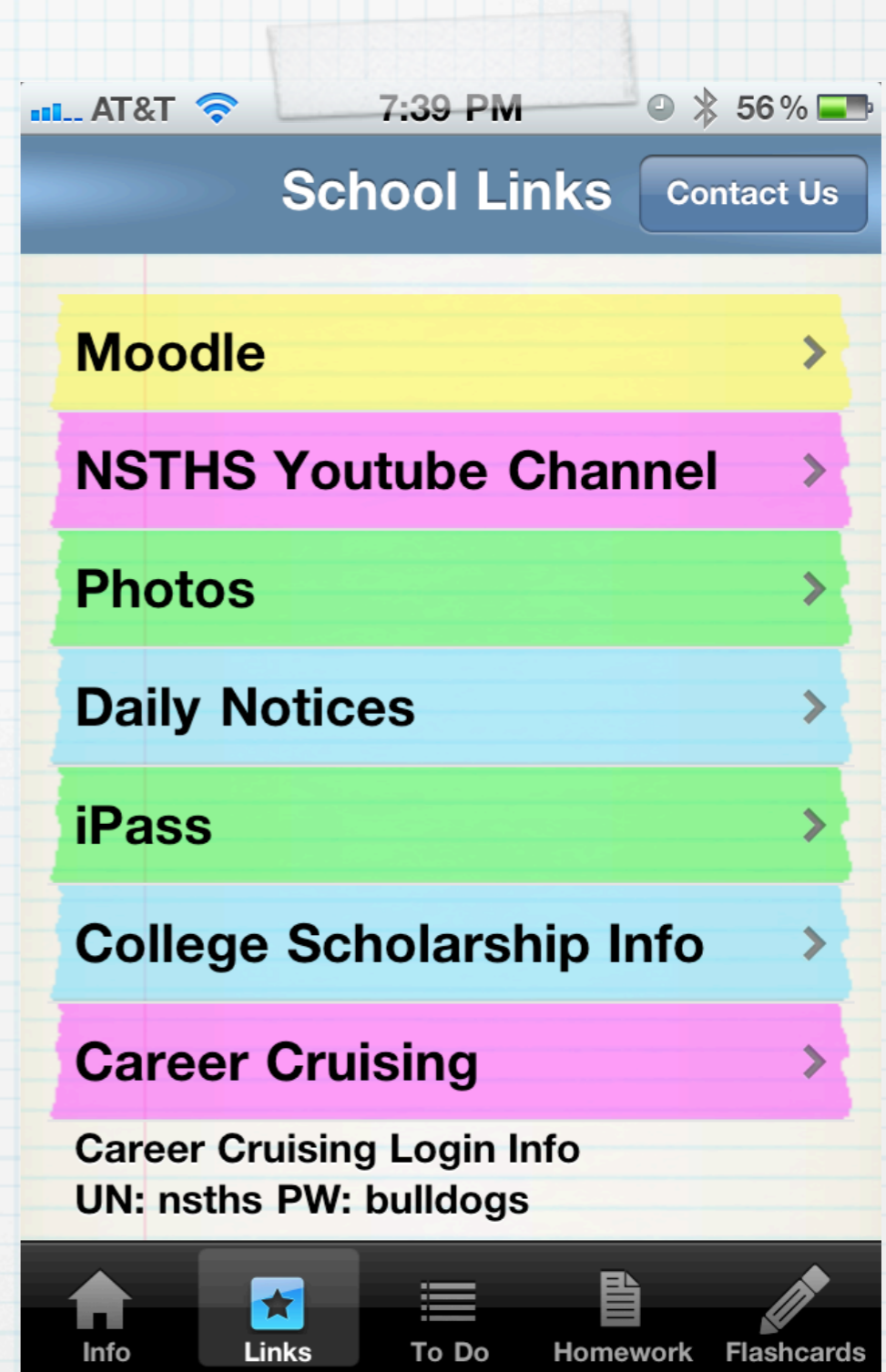


Examples of Use

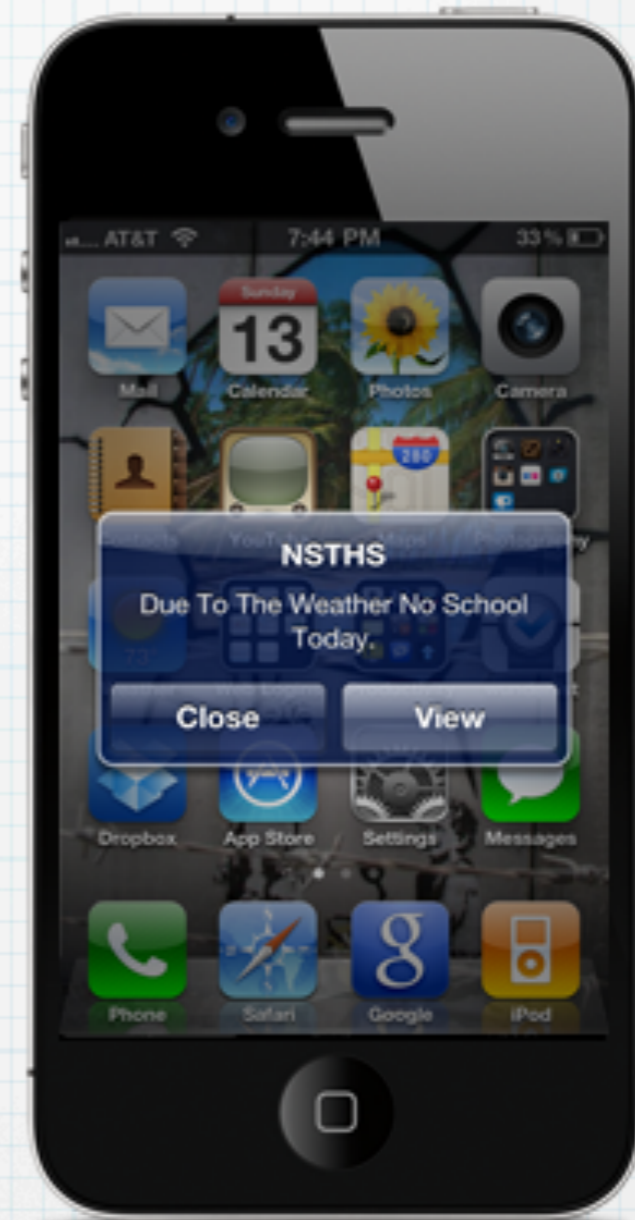
Provide important and useful links

Provides another way to get messages out quickly. Supplements services like Blackboard Connect. Also allows for quick reminders.

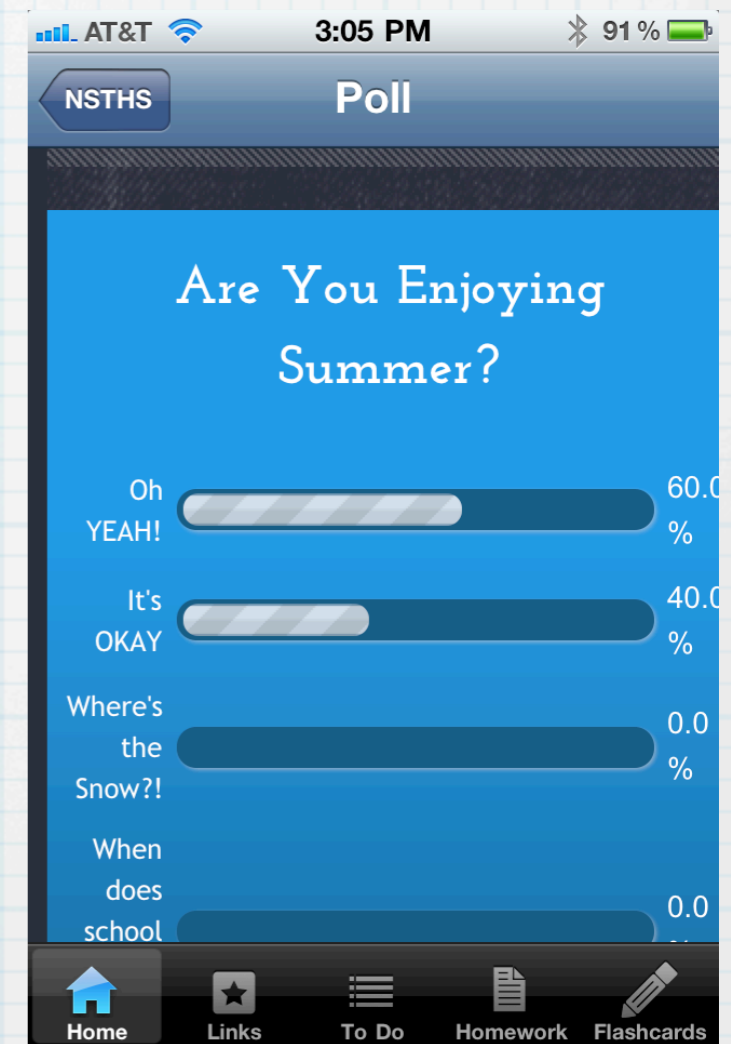


Example Of Use

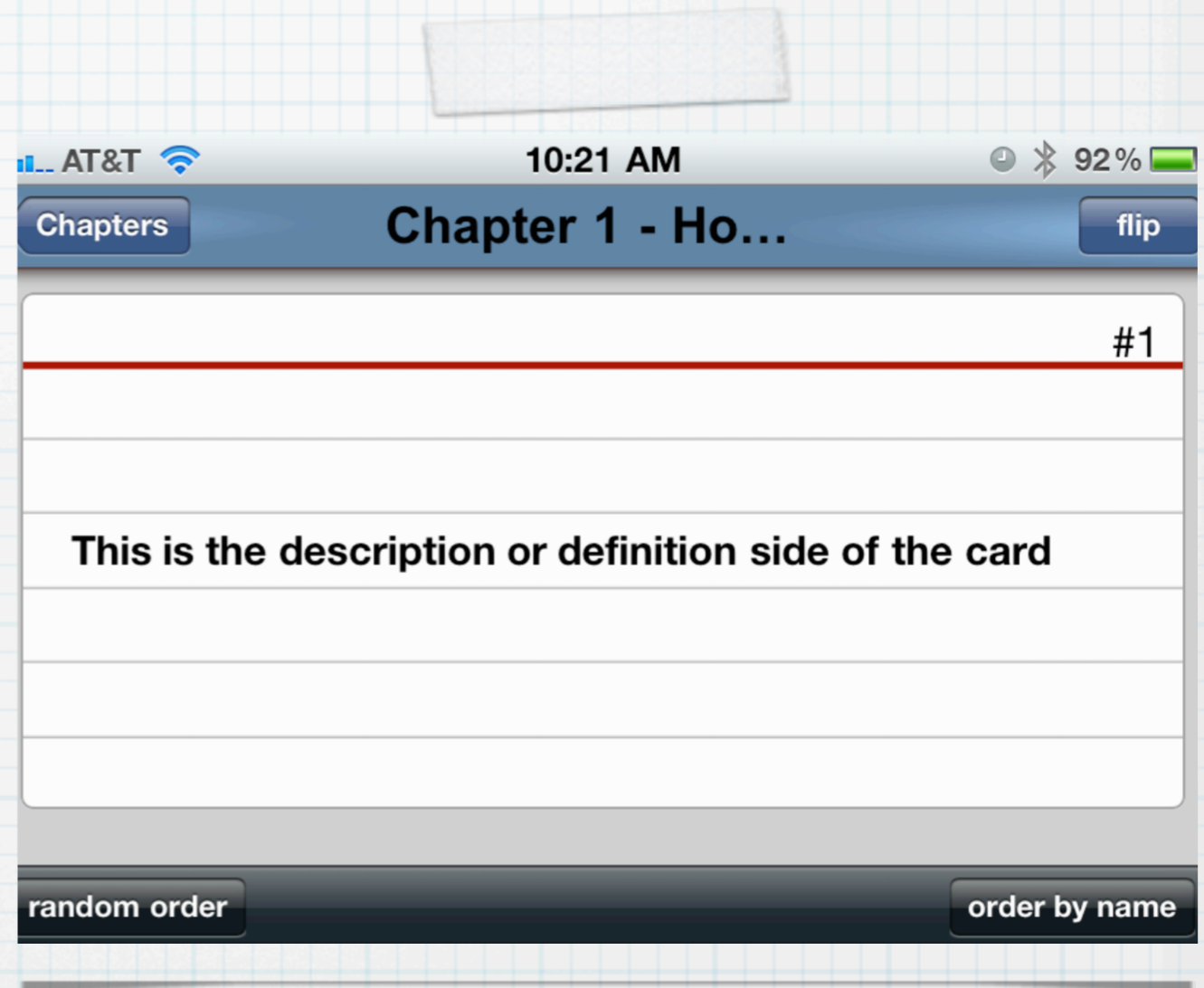
